


WALKING IN THE SHOES OF AN ARRERNTE WOMAN ELDER

M.K. Turner is an Eastern Arrernte elder, artist, humanitarian, author, language interpreter and teacher. She was one of the founders of the Irrkerlanyte Learning Centre and plays an on-going role as cultural advisor to many organisations working with Aboriginal people in and around Alice Springs.

M.K. is visiting Sydney in September and has agreed to host an interactive workshop for interested Pittwater residents (including teenagers) to explain how Arrernte people understand and manage their relationships with each other and with all forms of life, the land and the universe.

This workshop promises to be both fun and an interesting learning experience for people of all ages. It will help to better understand what it means to be an Aboriginal person and the central role of kinship, ceremony and the land to everyday Aboriginal life.
