Scotland Island Power Supply Improvements

Community Newsletter – August 2013

Ausgrid is upgrading the local electricity network on Scotland Island to improve safety and reliability.

When and where work is taking place

Existing power poles will be replaced along Thompson St and Hilda Ave as shown on the right. We anticipate the majority of works to be completed within the timeframes below.

28 Aug for approx 8 weekdays – New pole holes will be excavated by hand for three poles on Thompson St (outside house numbers 85-95, opposite house numbers 48-58)

Another hole is to be excavated during the same time period in order to relocate the pole at the top of Hilda Ave (see map on right)

WE ANTICIPATE THERE WILL BE NO POWER INTERRUPTION WHILST POST HOLES ARE BEING EXCAVATED

September (week commencing 9th) for approx one week – Installation of new poles

Vehicle access along Thompson St and Hilda Ave (shown in red to the right) will be closed during the work hours of 7.30am to 4pm.

September (week commencing 16th) - Transfer of overhead conductors onto new poles at correct height.

AT LEAST 4 DAYS NOTICE WILL BE GIVEN TO AFFECTED RESIDENTS PRIOR TO ANY PLANNED INTERRUPTION TO THE POWER SUPPLY

Work Hours

Work is planned to start at 7.30am and finish at 4pm on weekdays only. Note the above dates marked in red text are approximate as the work is dependent on weather conditions and may be postponed.


An ecologist will be on site during the pole installations.

Keeping you informed


Our aim is to minimise any inconvenience by keeping you updated of our work. Please note additional localised works will take place late September into early October however you will be notified again prior to work starting.
