The Ministry of Transport, in line with the recommendation from IPART the (Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal), has increased fares by 1.5%

As a result our new fare schedule, from 1st January 2011, is as follows:

The cost of the 13-trip Green ticket is \$60. To reduce the ferry's footprint we invest your extra \$1.00 into certified carbon credits.
