

COLLECTION FROM ROADSIDE ONLY



Please place metals in a separate pile. Remove any doors from fridges and furniture. All large items (e.g. trampolines, clothes hoists, outdoor heaters) must be disassembled and in parts that can be readily loaded by one person.

- Collection from roadside only.
- Remove any doors from fridges and furniture.
- Items only to be placed out two days prior to collection date.
- Do not place materials at public wharves or private wharves and jetties. Fines apply for illegal dumping.
- Help Council recover and recycle as much as possible. Place metals and whitegoods in a separate pile.

Maximum 3 cubic metres in total per collection
Maximum length 1.2 metres per item

COMPUTERS AND TVS

Computers and TVs are not accepted. This includes computer monitors, personal and portable computers, printers, scanners, computer peripherals and parts, cords and cables.

Residents in a car, ute or trailer may deliver up to 15 items FREE at Kimbriki. All computers and TVs taken to Kimbriki will be recycled.



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Appliances such as stoves and fridges (please remove doors)
- Frames with glass removed (break glass down, wrap in newspaper and put in garbage bin)



- Paint tins and fuel containers are accepted with the lid off and no liquid
- Manageable quantities of: non branded delivery pallets, wooden stairs, decking, gates, fencing, guttering, down piping, iron sheets and water tanks - must be cut down to 1.2 metre lengths and one person must be able to lift the item. Nails must not stick out, please hammer down
- Hot water systems (empty)

Where possible metals will be kept separate and taken to Kimbriki Recycling & Waste Facility for re-processing and re-use.

Place metals in a separate pile to other general clean up materials

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Asbestos
- Batteries and household chemicals
- Building materials e.g. wall linings (gyprock etc.)/studs/timber beams/tiles/concrete



- Car, motor and boat parts/rubber from tyres (rims are acceptable)
- Food
- Gas bottles
- Glass including windows/panes/mirrors/panels/shower screens/picture frames.
- Liquid paints/oils/fuel
- Recyclable materials paper/cardboard
- Soil/earth/fill/bricks
- Soiled wrappings
- Vegetation/plants.

Unacceptable Items will not be collected

GARDEN ORGANICS - ROADSIDE



- Max 2 cubic metres in total.
- Branches to be max 1.2m long and 75mm thick tied with twine.
- Place garden organics in a hard sided container.
- Place materials on the roadside no later than 6am prior to collection date.
- ✓ 100% of the garden organics collected will be recycled at Kimbriki Resource Recovery Centre.
- Material presented in plastic, nylon or hessian bags, cardboard or foam boxes or untied bundles will not be collected.
- Do not place materials at public wharves or private wharves/jetties. Fines apply for illegal dumping.

Accepted Garden Organics



^{*}Council encourages home composting and worm farming. Food scraps and kitchen waste are 100% recyclable if treated properly.

- Plastic bags
- General waste
- Solution Food scraps and kitchen waste*
- Painted & treated timber
- Soil Soil
- Large tree stumps and roots



GARBAGE

Monday & Friday Collection - Wharfs Only

- Garbage is collected from public and private wharves every Monday & Friday.
- Collections from private wharves will only be carried out if year round tidal access is available.
- Waste services run on public holidays.
- Food scraps, plastic bags and wrappings, food soiled paper and pizza boxes, nappies, light bulbs (excluding fluorescent tubes), foam packaging, broken crockery, mirrors and window glass. All broken glass to be wrapped in newspaper.
- No builders' waste, vegetation or general clean up items.



CONTAINER RECYCLING

Monday Roadside Collection in Crates Only

- Glass
- Aluminium
- Aerosol or steel cans
- Milk and juice cartons
- Plastic containers numbered 1 - 7
- Plastic bags
- Cling film
- Ceramics
- White glass or polystyrene



PAPER RECYCLING

Monday Roadside Collection in Crates Only

- Newspapers & magazines
- Cardboard
- Telephone books
- Cereal boxes
- Envelopes
- Egg cartons & office paper
- Plastic bags
- ₩ax cardboard
- Dirty pizza boxes or food-soiled paper

Larger boxes to be broken into smaller pieces to fit into crates.

If your property has year round tidal access and you would like a bin and hoop stand installed on your private wharf/jetty please contact Northern Beaches Council on 9970 1111. This is a free service.

An extra garbage service will be provided on Wednesdays in summer as indicated on calendar. Replacement recycling crates are free. Please call 9970 1111.

REPORT ILLEGAL DUMPING



No vegetation or general clean up materials to be placed at public wharves. Fines for illegal dumping will apply.

Dumped material pollutes the environment and can harm wildlife and native flora.

If you see someone dumping material in our reserves, wharves or bushland areas, please take note of any registration details, description of the vehicle/vessel, person, date and time, then report it to Council. Any dumped material should be reported (whether the person responsible is known or not) so that Council can take action and investigate the matter.

Did you know that you can be fined or prosecuted for transporting waste to a place that cannot legally accept it? Legal waste facilities are Kimbriki Resource Recovery Centre at Terrey Hills kimbriki.com.au and SITA at Belrose sita.com.au

Please check beforehand which facility can take your load of waste materials.

PUBLIC WHARF BINS

Public wharf garbage bins are provided for the disposal of domestic garbage waste only.

Please do not dispose of construction waste, chemical waste or garden organic waste in the garbage bins provided on the public wharves.

Building materials, gas bottles, car/boat parts,



motor oil, paint, computer and batteries can be taken to either Kimbriki or Belrose Resource Recovery Centres. See page 2 of this waste calendar to learn where to dispose of these common products.

A garden organics roadside collection is offered twice per year. See information within this calendar. Chemical waste can be disposed of in the household chemical cleanout.

Materials that will be accepted at Chemical Clean Outs include:

- Paint and paint-related products (thinners, strippers, varnish etc.)
- Motor oils, fuels and fluids
- Gas bottles
- Pool chemicals
- Hobby chemicals (photography chemicals etc.)
- Pesticides and herbicides (fungicides, baits/poisons and wood preservatives)
- Solvents and household cleaners
- Batteries
- Fire extinguishers
- Acids and alkalis
- Fluorescent tubes
