MACKEREL BEACH RESIDENTS

Place materials on the grassed area at the southern side of the public wharf. Prior to the collection, the waste contractor will install a temporary barrier so that metals can be placed separately from general clean up items.

OTHER WESTERN FORESHORES RESIDENTS

Place materials at the public wharves. Residents with a private wharf waste service and year round tidal access can place their materials on their wharf/jetty/pontoon.

- ✔ Please place metals in a separate pile. All large items (e.g. trampolines, clothes hoists, outdoor heaters) must be disassembled and in parts that can be readily loaded by one person.
- ✘ No glass including windows, doors, picture frames and coffee tables etc to prevent injuries if the glass breaks.
- ✔ Remove any doors from fridges and furniture.
- ✔ Items only to be placed out two days prior to collection date.

Maximum 3 cubic metres in total per collection














Maximum length 1.2 metres per item

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED IN THE GENERAL CLEAN UPS

Computers and TVs are not accepted. This include computer monitors, personal and portable computers, printers, scanners, computer peripherals and parts, cords and cables.

Residents in a car, ute or trailer may deliver up to 15 items FREE at Kimbriki. All computers and TVs taken to Kimbriki will be recycled.



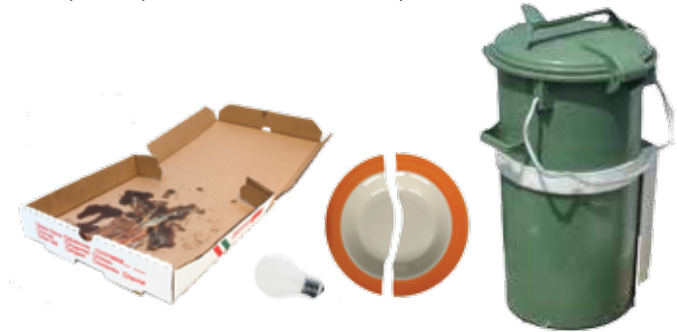

GARBAGE

Monday & Friday Collections from Wharves Only



- ✔ Garbage is collected from public and private wharves every Monday & Friday.
- ✔ An extra garbage service will be provided on Wednesdays in summer as indicated on calendar.
- ✔ Collections from private wharves will only be carried out if year round tidal access is available.
- ✔ Food scraps, plastic bags and wrappings, food soiled paper and pizza boxes, nappies, light bulbs (excluding fluorescent tubes), foam packaging, broken crockery, mirrors and window glass. All broken glass to be wrapped in newspaper.
- ✘ No builders' waste, vegetation or general clean up items.

If your property has year round tidal access and you would like a bin and hoop stand installed on your private wharf/jetty please contact Council on 9970 1111. This is a free service.



CONTAINER RECYCLING

Monday & Friday Collections from Wharves Only

- ✓ Only glass, aluminium, aerosol cans, steel cans, milk and juice cartons and plastic containers numbered 1 - 7.
- ✓ An extra recycling service will be provided on Wednesdays in summer as indicated on calendar.
- ✓ Collections from private wharves will only be carried out if year round tidal access is available.
- ✓ If your property has year round tidal access and you would like a recycling crate delivered to your private wharf/jetty please contact Council on 9970 1111. This is a free service.
- ✗ NO plastic bags, cling film, ceramics, white glass or polystyrene.
- ✗ NO e-waste. Must be recycled at Kimbriki.

PAPER RECYCLING

Monday & Friday Collections from Wharves Only

- ✓ Only newspapers, magazines, cardboard, telephone books, cereal boxes, envelopes, egg cartons and office paper.
- ✓ An extra recycling service will be provided on Wednesdays in summer as indicated on calendar.
- ✓ Collections from private wharves will only be carried out if year round tidal access is available.
- ✓ If your property has year round tidal access and you would like a recycling crate delivered to your private wharf/jetty please contact Council on 9970 1111. This is a free service.
- ✗ NO plastic bags, wax cardboard, dirty pizza boxes or food-soiled paper.

REPORT ILLEGAL DUMPING



No vegetation or general clean up materials to be placed at public wharves. Fines for illegal dumping will apply.

Dumped material pollutes the environment and can harm wildlife and native flora.

If you see someone dumping material in our reserves, wharves or bushland areas, please take note of any registration details, description of the vehicle/vessel, person, date and time, then report it to Council. Any dumped material should be reported (whether the person responsible is known or not) so that Council can take action and investigate the matter.

Did you know that you can be fined or prosecuted for transporting waste to a place that cannot legally accept it? Legal waste facilities are Kimbriki Resource Recovery Centre at Terrey Hills kimbriki.com.au and SITA at Belrose sita.com.au

Please check beforehand which facility can take your load of waste materials.

PUBLIC WHARF BINS

Public wharf garbage bins are provided for the disposal of domestic garbage waste only.

Please do not dispose of construction waste, chemical waste or garden organic waste in the garbage bins provided on the public wharves.

Building materials, gas bottles, car/boat parts, motor oil, paint, computer and batteries can be taken to either Kimbriki or Belrose Resource Recovery Centres. See page 2 of this waste calendar to learn where to dispose of these common products.

Onsite household composting is recommended for garden organics. Chemical waste can be disposed of in the household chemical cleanout.

Materials that will be accepted at Chemical Clean Outs include:

- ✔ Paint and paint-related products (*thinners, strippers, varnish etc.*)
- ✔ Motor oils, fuels and fluids
- ✔ Gas bottles
- ✔ Pool chemicals
- ✔ Hobby chemicals (*photography chemicals etc.*)
- ✔ Pesticides and herbicides (*fungicides, baits/poisons and wood preservatives*)
- ✔ Solvents and household cleaners
- ✔ Batteries
- ✔ Fire extinguishers
- ✔ Acids and alkalis
- ✔ Fluorescent tubes
