

# Your Waste & Recycling Guide

 Extra summer garbage service begins **Wednesday 11 December** for public and private wharves with year round tidal access

 Vegetation collection method may vary between offshore communities. **Residents will be advised how to present vegetation** for collection.

 Items must be **in the bin with the lid closed flat** to avoid litter

**Paper Recycling**  
Monday and Friday  
Private wharves only

- ✓ Office paper
- ✓ Newspaper / magazines
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Flattened clean cardboard
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Window envelopes
- ✓ Egg cartons

- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Wax cardboard
- ✗ Dirty parts of pizza box
- ✗ Food soiled paper
- ✗ Milk / juice cartons
- ✗ Nappies



**Container Recycling**  
Monday and Friday  
Private wharves only

- ✓ Glass bottles
- ✓ Jars
- ✓ Milk / juice cartons
- ✓ Empty aerosols
- ✓ Steel / aluminium cans
- ✓ Plastic containers

- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Cling film
- ✗ Windows / glass / mirrors
- ✗ Ceramics / drinking glass
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ White glass



**Vegetation**  
New twice yearly service


- ✓ Branches max 75mm wide
- ✓ Leaves
- ✓ Garden / grass clippings
- ✓ Cut up palm fronds
- ✓ Twigs
- ✓ Flowers


- ✗ General waste
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Painted & treated timber
- ✗ Soil
- ✗ Large tree stumps


**Don't send all your items to landfill - give them a second life.** Consider the many ways you can sell, recycle or upcycle before you present your items for collection.


## Bulky Goods Collection Service


Offshore communities receive **two scheduled bulky goods collections per year.**


 Hot water systems **must be emptied**

 Ensure **nails are not protruding** from any items

 Large items **must be dismantled** so two people can load

 Manageable quantities of **non branded delivery pallets** are accepted

 Paint tins and fuel containers are accepted **empty, with the lid off**

 **Remove glass from frames** (break glass, wrap in paper and place in garbage bin)

- ✗ TVs & computers
- ✗ Building / renovation material
- ✗ Car parts, tyres & batteries
- ✗ Gas bottles & extinguishers
- ✗ Vegetation
- ✗ Cardboard & paper
- ✗ Windows / glass / mirrors
- ✗ Items smaller than a toaster

**Mackerel Beach residents** place materials within the temporary fenced grassed area at the southern side of the public wharf. There will be a separate fenced section for metals.

**Other Western Foreshore residents** place materials at the public wharves. If you have a private wharf waste service and year round tidal access you can place your material on your wharf/jetty/pontoon.
