Church Point Ferry Service holds regular safety training sessions. After our recent training, our drivers' highest safety concerns are about you, their Passengers, or the residents. We have concerns about injury onboard the ferry, as well as boats with no lights or inadequate lights and kids jumping into ferry wash (Not in winter obviously!), so I wanted to pass this along.

- Please take care when boarding and disembarking.
- Please remain seated whilst the vessel is in motion.
- Please keep your children near to you and also seated. Do not let them run around.

We would also ask that all residents please have good lights on their boats. We would hate to have an accident. We would also ask that parents ask their children not to jump in ferry wash, as there have been accidents at wharves accessed by other ferry operators not in this immediate area.

Lastly, all School children must have a valid ferry pass or the correct fare. All School children must obey the Code of conduct as published by Transport for NSW.
