8 HILL OF CONTENT 2005 CABERNET SAUVIGNON. A very flavoursome & smooth wine with good varietal definition. McLaren Vale grapes. 14.0% alc. \$6.75	81

Two heavy frosts in October 2006 reduced the potential yield by 75% but the surviving grapes had more intense cherry flavours with great depth of colour. Prolonged maturation in French oak has produced a spicy (cinnamon) wine with more structure than a typical pinot. Only 60 cases available. Not available for tasting .
