



IMPORTANT UPDATE TO RESIDENTS

3 March 2014

WORKS ARE TAKING LONGER TO COMPLETE THAN ANTICIPATED DUE TO WET WEATHER AND THE SWITCH BACK TO NORMAL POWER SUPPLY WILL NOT OCCUR TODAY.

There will be a power outage on Friday 7 March from 0800hrs to 1500hrs. See attached outage notification. This outage will affect the whole of the island.

We ask that while on diesel generation that residents limit the use of electrical appliances wherever possible.

The barge currently located at Bells Wharf is to **remain** until works cease.

Richard Rd will again be blocked at the top of the Vivian St stairs during this time however the remainder of Richard Rd loop will be open.

Under Section 52 of the Electricity Supply Act 1995, the network operator (Ausgrid) may interrupt the supply of the electricity to a customer at such reasonable times as Ausgrid determines.

We suggest you take some basic precautions before and during the interruption:

- Unplug or switch off appliances at the wall as well as garage doors and alarms. If you're at home, leave a light on to tell you when power is back.
- Notify your security company of the interruption to make sure alarms operate correctly without power.
- Switch off water pumps and three phase motors associated with air conditioning plants and lifts.
- Avoid opening fridges or freezers. Frozen food can last for 24 hours if the freezer door is left closed. Food in fridges can last for about 10 hours.
