

# Pittwater Public Wharves DRAFT PLAN OF MANAGEMENT

## Eastern Wharf, Scotland Island

### Key Issues

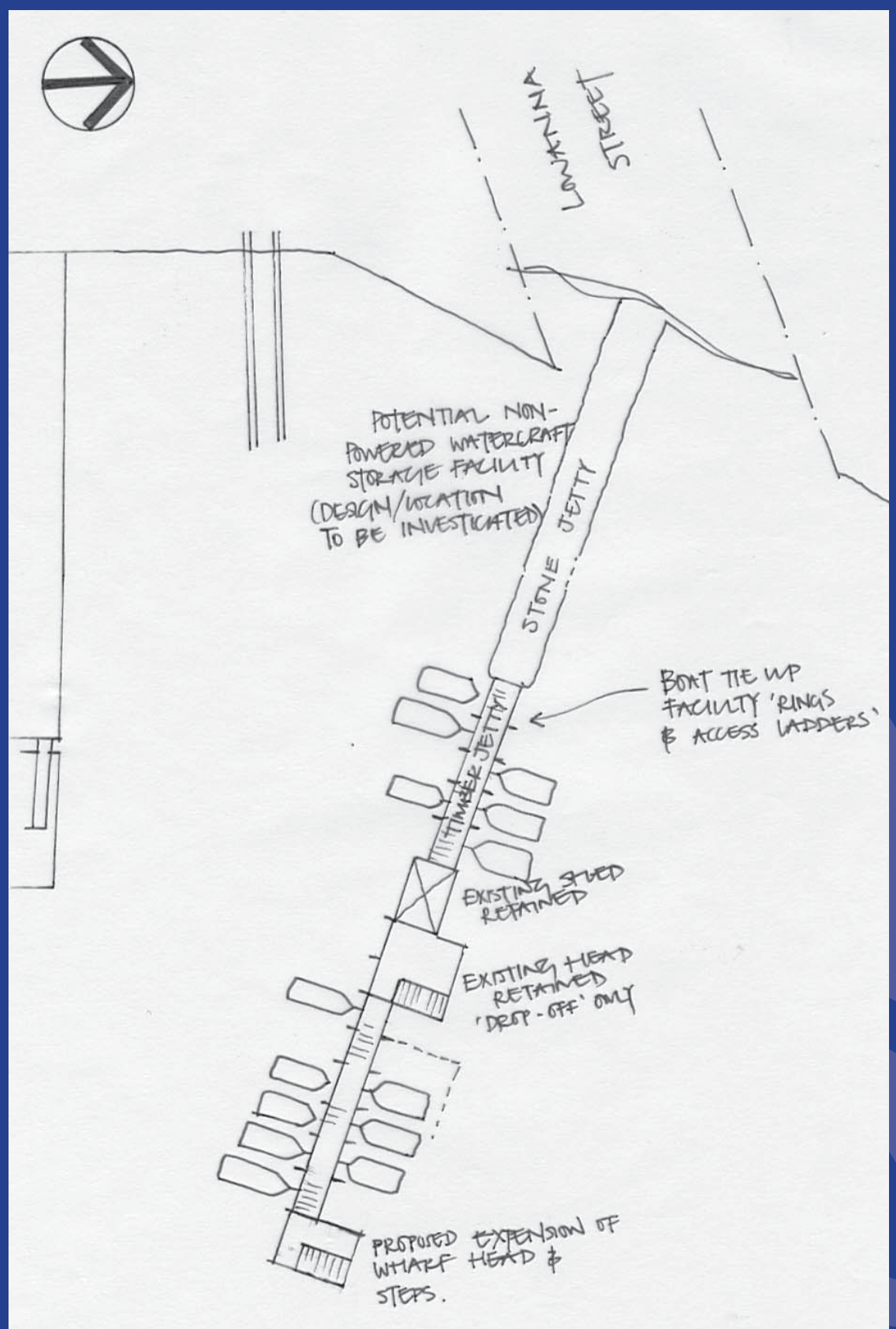
- pedestrian access to ferry / taxi / private vessels etc. via steps
- short wharf length / majority of wharf in shallow waters = limited space for vessel tie-up
- lack of non-powered watercraft storage areas
- very exposed / strong prevailing weather conditions

### Concept Plan (indicative only)

- install safety equipment
- provision of boat tie-up facilities to existing wharf structure (access via ladders)
- extend wharf head to deeper waters, construct jetty with new wharf head / step access
- provision of further boat tie-up facilities to new jetty length
- non-powered watercraft storage area

### Note:

PRELIMINARY DESIGN ONLY, potential allowance for access ramp and pontoons to be further investigated.



Note: Indicative only - Concept subject to further detailed design development. Number of allocated boat tie-up spaces may vary from plan according to specific wharf composition.

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
