The following is agreed:

- 1) That an agency relationship exists between the above parties
- 2) That the artist authorises the RMYC to issue tax invoices for sales on their behalf
- 3) The Artist is required to account for the GST payable on the supply, being 10% of the value which is the amount the agent is actually required to pay the Artist. This amount is the price charged to the third party, less the amount the agent is permitted to keep as commission.

Under these circumstances, the agent's supply of services is not a taxable supply and the Artist is not entitled to claim input tax credits relating to the commission.

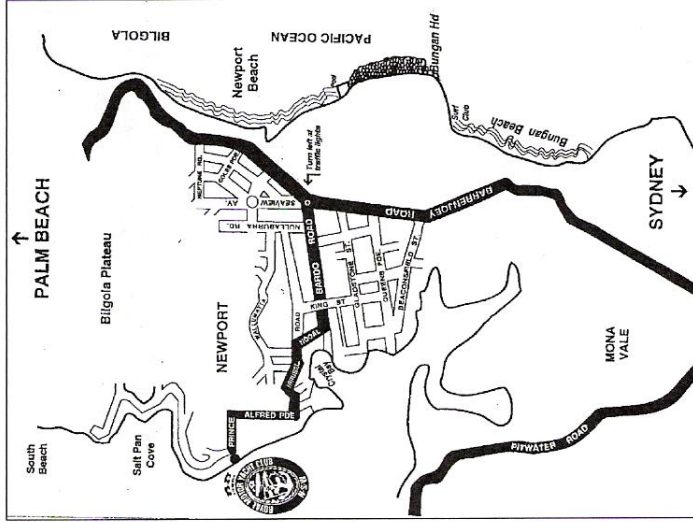

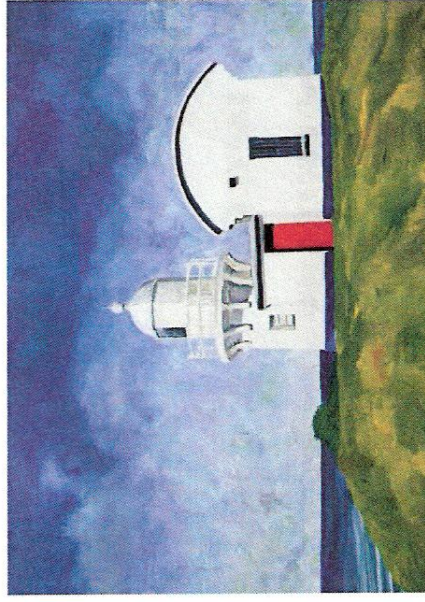
