Scotland Island Vehicle Access Permit

Council is progressing the implementation of the Scotland Island Traffic Management Plan and the associated Vehicle Access Permit.

As part of the process to complete the implementation Council staff have arranged for authorised inspectors to undertake the preliminary inspection of Buggies and Light Utility Vehicles, in line with the requirements (attached) for Conditional Registration.

Staff will be in attendance to issue the access permits on the day and answer any questions that you may have regarding this project and assist in progressing the conditional registration of any currently non-compliant.

The staff and inspector will be onsite on the following days and times to check vehicles and issue permits. Bookings will be required for logistical purposes and to meet the Covid-safe requirements. **An inspection fee of \$80.00 will apply (third party inspection fee, not a Council charge).**

Please go to the Council website and book an inspection time slot for your vehicle, unless it has current registration.
