

Community Vehicle Service Notice - Coronavirus COVID 19

For the health and safety of our volunteer drivers and passengers we ask that that you refrain from using the community vehicle if you are feeling unwell.

Similarly people in self-isolation at the direction of medical or health authorities should also refrain from using the community vehicle.

Effective immediately the following service restrictions will apply:

- Service hours will be **limited from 9am to 7pm**
- Service only available for essential travel e.g. shopping and supplies
- Service not available for social or recreational purposes
- Passengers restricted to **maximum of 2 people** and must travel in the rear seat only
- To minimise the handling of cash, **fares are to be deposited into a cash tin**
- Passengers are requested to have the correct fare as **change will no longer be given**

As the coronavirus pandemic plays out, further service restrictions may become necessary, such as restricting the number of days the vehicle is operational.

Accordingly, customers are requested to ring the community vehicle before going shopping to confirm that it is operational.

Easylink regrets having to impose these service restrictions, but believes they are necessary to reduce the risk to our volunteer drivers and passengers, so that we can continue to provide this essential transport service for the Island community.
