

Community Vehicle Report
October 2015



The key development since the last meeting has been the delivery of the new vehicle and the completion of the transition to the Easy Transport administration of the scheme.

The new vehicle transition went smoothly and overall operation has continued with no significant issues.

The major challenge has been that the hairpin bend issue has meant that we have not been able to service the top of the island. With the interim repairs underway this issue should be resolved shortly.

The vehicle will be off the island for a period next week to have tonneau cover and reversing spotlights fitted.

Discussion Items for SIRAC: We have had two requests:

- 1 The management of the Kindy made contact through Ian Laughton-Smith. As discussed at last meeting, the numbers at Kindy are low and threaten its sustainability and so they have requested that we look at whether the previous discount for trips to Kindy to transport children could be re-instated.
- 2 To note, some community members have “pre-paid” for a number of trips by Karmel so she is able to use the community vehicle to carry her shopping home.
