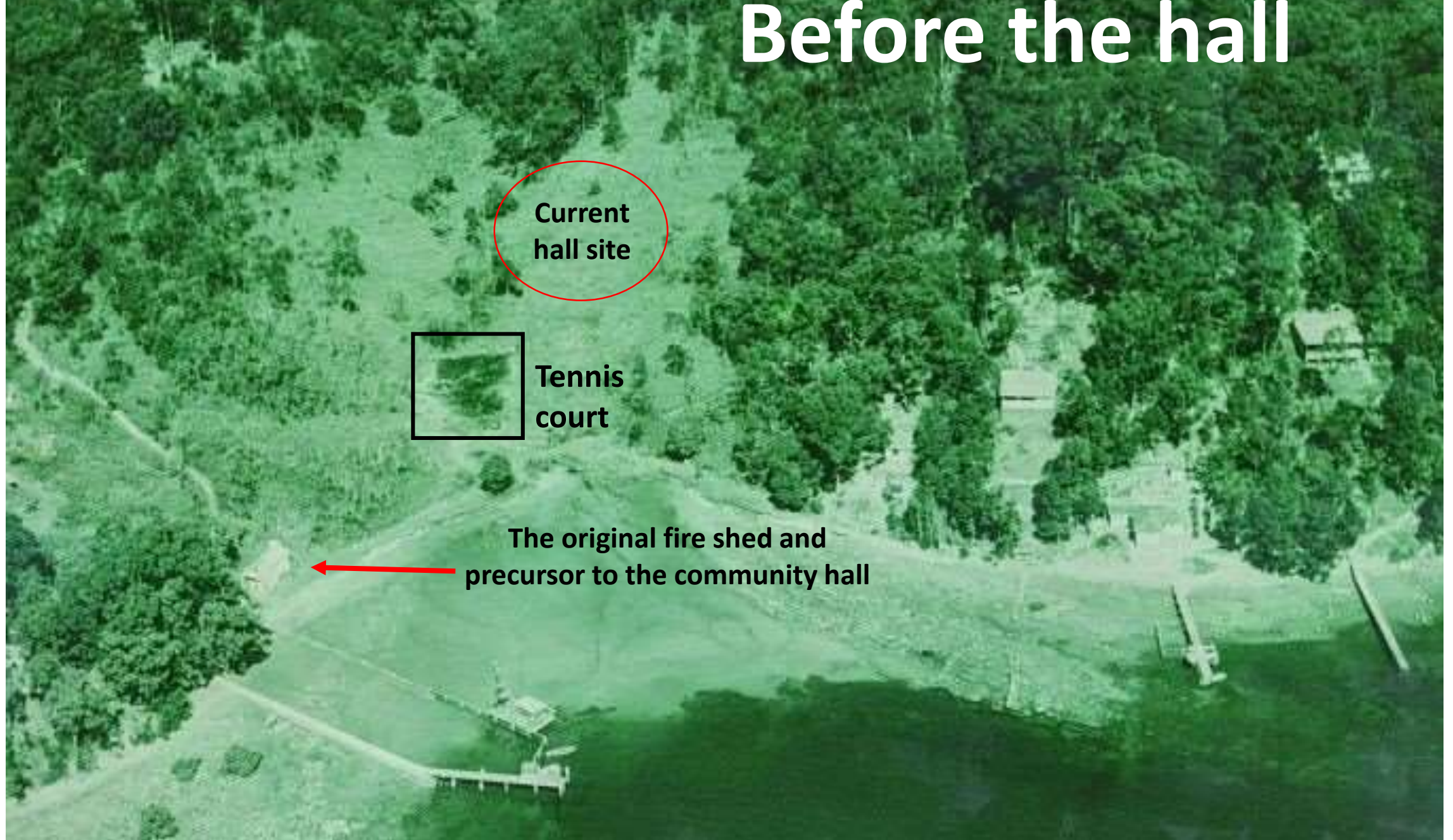

CATHERINE BENNS

(1838-1920) came to live on Scotland Island in the 1860's. She became known as the 'Queen of Scotland Island' and was a famous midwife.



CATHERINE BOUFFIER

(1857-1940) was the mother-in-law of Herbert James Fitzpatrick (1889-1938) who owned land on Scotland Island and other parts of Pittwater. Fitzpatrick named this park, as well as Florence Terrace, Elvina Bay and others.

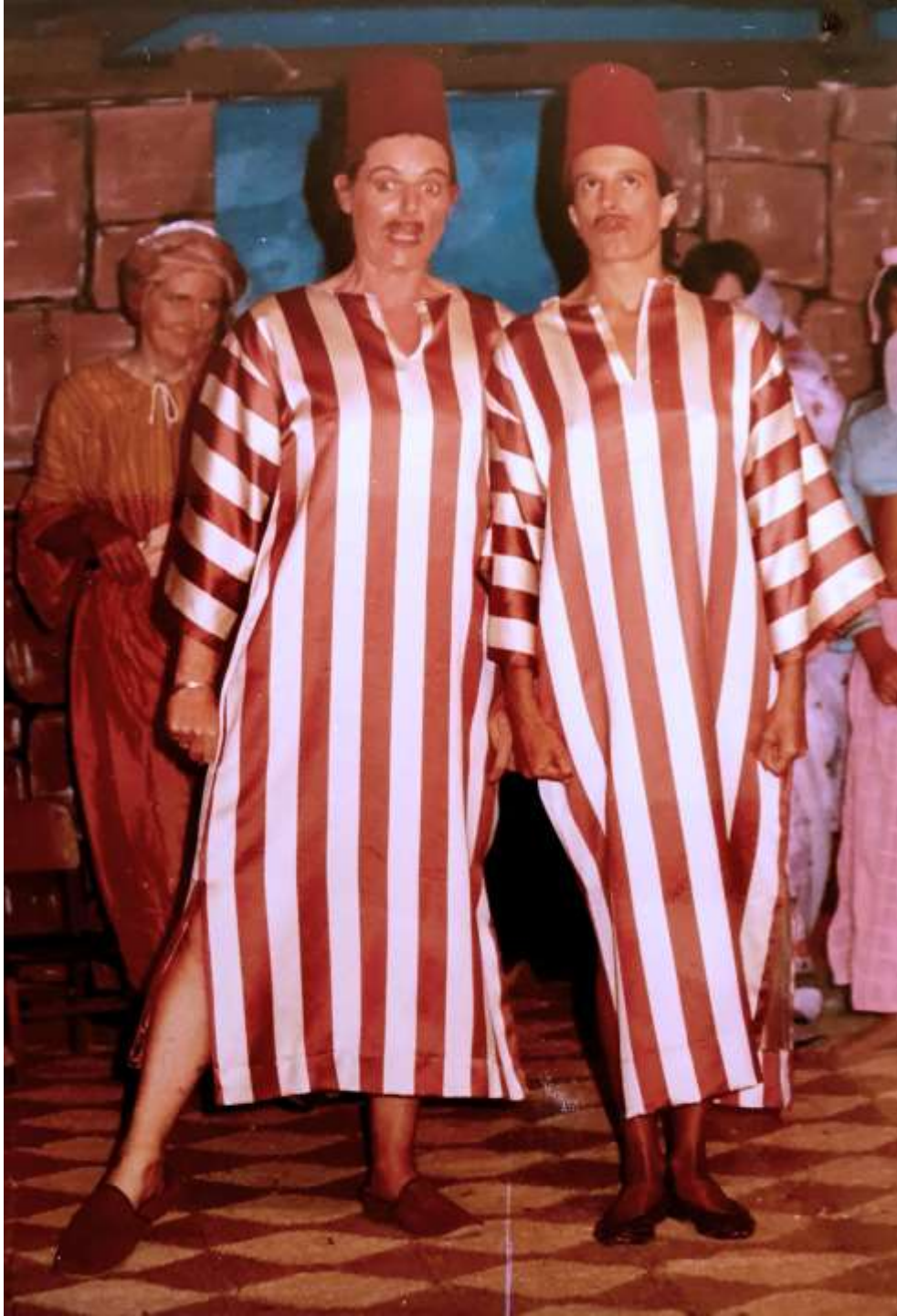
