1. Review YE 2023 Budget

Water sales have increased year on year and funds in Australian Ethical Investments remains healthy.

Sharon K queried if any funding is available for Bushcare Maintenance etc, as all previous grant funding has been applied through the Rec Club.

Boyd confirmed that in addition to the EW Manager allowance of \$4,050, the EW Line Maintenance allowance of \$8,200 has not been spent so therefore may be available.

2. Discuss transfer of funds from Australian Ethical Investments
