Report to SIRAC Jan 2015

Updates since last meeting:

There have been followup phone/email discussions with PWC on the two main current issues- skips and green waste.

Jetty Skips Update from PWC

1. Skip bin upgrade is starting this week, in the next two weeks the bins should be installed;

2. Signage upgrade will be undertaken as soon as the bins are in place;

3. PWC are investigating the use of surveillance cameras on the wharves to combat illegal dumping;

4. PWC will forward their communications regarding the change this week so we can include it in a PON or other communication.

Green Waste Update

- PWC are aware of the inequity in access to green waste between offshore and mainland and are looking for external funding (EPA) for a more systematic approach to offshore waste overall. (Note that other offshore have no green waste removal at all.)
- 2. They are already looking at using some EPA funding for some sort of offshore composting/worm farming project (not sure where this is supposed to go yet)
- 3. Looking at providing a commercial mulching service 2-4 times per year but are aware of the potential weed distribution issues
- 4. As the overall waste contract expires in 2017 they would like input from the community on all issues as the "wish list" for the tender is assembled.
