

Waste Management Sub-committee report June 2015

June Report:

Issues raised from community discussed with PWC are:

1 That the skips at Bell seem to be getting very full- is there room for a fourth one?

Response- PWC will investigate if it's possible to install a 4th one on Bells. The problem is that URM had agreed to provide exact capacity as before the switch over, so if we install another one that will exceed the capacity by 1000 litre, which means they have to get the sign off for a contract variance.

2 Update on the smaller lids for the skips to minimize incorrect usage (someone put another mattress in there last week!)

Response- The lids are supposed to be switched over by late June. Meeting with URM this week to get the exact date.

3 Ongoing issues with collection of recycling to top of island in wet weather. **Response-** PWC will discuss with URM

4 Chipper and/or extra green waste to deal with all the post-storm additional vegetation

Response- Post-storm vegetation clean up is still a go. Council is still deciding whether it will have internal staff to collect or have URM do it. I'm still waiting a decision to be made. I've been told a decision will be made this week. "My recommendation is to keep the pressure from your end so they can make a call ASAP."
